SEND SUCCESSES

We currently have Miss Robbens as part of our team. She has joined as Deputy SENDCO, to add additional provision and support to our team. She is currently completing her NASENCo qualification, which will lead on to her becoming a fully qualified SENDCO



All our year 10, 11 and 6th form pupils have been tested to see if they qualify for access arrangements for their exams. We will be testing our current year 9's in June, to make sure they also receive this support. We pride ourselves on making sure all our pupils are tested for this provision.

At Skegness Academy we have created a SEND hub safe space that we are very proud of. The hub features a sensory room, which pupils can access to regulate their emotions, and offers rabbit therapy to help calm pupils. The space can be accessed by SEND pupils when they are struggling in the classroom and offers an additional layer of support to our SEND pupils.





One of our new ideas to support SEND pupils coming into the Academy in September, is to have SEND Ambassadors. These are Academy pupils, who have a SEND diagnosis themselves, and they offer support to our new pupils and help them settle into the Academy comfortably.

We are very proud of all the intervention we offer within the Academy. We offer intervention with literacy, numeracy, handwriting and dyslexia, as well as incorporating Lego Therapy and SEMH support.
